



SIMPLIFI COOKIES POLICY

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1. Introduction

This policy governs the use of cookies on www.simplifi.ro website and its subdomains owned by Simpliworks SRL (hereinafter referred to as „Simplifi”), as a data Controller.

Simpliworks with the registered office in 142 Gheorghe Țiteica Street, Țiteica Office Building, 3rd floor, District 2, Bucharest and is registered with the Trade Register Office under the no J2022006777401, and fiscal identification number (CUI) 45938180.

This Policy informs you about the cookies used, the personal data collected, the purpose of the data processing and, where applicable, the recipients of the data. The Privacy Policy on the use of cookies also contains information about your rights under Regulation (EU) No 2016/679 on the protection and processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as “GDPR”), where you can exercise these data or how you can delete cookies directly, using the settings of the operating system you use.

2. What are Cookies?

While visiting any website, it may store or retrieve information on your browser, mostly in the form of cookies. A cookie (“browser cookie” or “HTTP cookie”) is a small file, consisting of letters and numbers, which is stored on any terminal with Internet access (computer, mobile phone, tablet, etc.) and is installed by the request issued by a web server to a browser (ex: Firefox, Chrome).

3. What types of cookies do we use on our websites?

The websites belonging to Simplifi are using only strictly necessary cookies.

Strictly Necessary Cookies are placed on your device when accessing the Simplifi websites.

4. What data is processed through the use of cookies?

Strictly necessary cookies are needed for the operation of the website and cannot be disabled in our systems. They are configured to respond to and remember actions you take, such as setting privacy preferences, logging into the site or filling out forms. You can configure your browser to block or alert the presence of these cookies, but some parts of the site will no longer work. These cookies do not store personal information.

5. How long do we store the data processed through the use of cookies?

Given that the Simplifi website currently uses only strictly necessary cookies and that these are essential for the proper functioning of the site, their storage duration is limited to what is strictly necessary for their purpose. Specifically, these cookies are primarily session cookies which are automatically deleted from your device when you close your browser

You can, however, delete these cookies at any time through your browser settings.

6. How can I refuse the use of cookies and how can I subsequently change my browser settings related to cookies?

If you do not agree with the use of cookies or any provision of this Policy, you can block any cookie in your browser settings. This will not restrict your access to our website.

This allows you to adapt your browser settings to cookies. For example, if you are the only person using your device/equipment (computer, tablet, etc.) you can set your browser to clear your browsing data every time you close the browser. You can also do this if there are multiple users of the device, for example by sharing the computer used to browse our website.

You can also delete cookies, at any time using the "Privacy" option in the Settings category of your browser.

Disabling the option to accept cookies may mean that some of the most important sites cannot be accessed. It is therefore important that you only accept cookies from sites that you trust.

7. What are your data protection rights and how you can exercise them?

In accordance with the legal provisions in force (Articles 12-22 of the GDPR), you, as a data subject who has visited one of our websites using cookies, have the following rights: right of information, right of access to data, right of rectification and right of erasure of data, right of restriction, right of portability, right of objection, right not to be subject to processing based on processing carried out solely by automated means. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without the withdrawal of consent affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out prior to withdrawal. In addition, you have the right to address the National Authority for the Supervision of Personal Data and the courts.
